What?

The Missouri State Library is partnering with MOREnet to offer at **no charge**, three one-day training sessions on Web 2.0 applications such as wikis, blogs, and RSS feeds. This course is designed to provide an in-depth demonstration of these technologies and their application in expanding library services and connecting to new library users.

Who may attend?

Staff members who are responsible for managing technology in public libraries are eligible to attend. Applications are handled on a first-come, first-served basis, with a maximum of 18 attendees permitted. No more than two staff members from the same library system will be allowed to enroll.

When?

Classes begin on Tuesday, August 12 at 1:30 p.m. and run through Friday, August 15 at 11:30 a.m.

Where?

Course sessions will be conducted at MOREnet's main office at 3212A LeMone Industrial Boulevard in Columbia. Lodging will be provided for participants Tuesday, August 12 through Thursday, August 14, at the Best Western Inn at 3100 I-70 Drive, SE in Columbia. Cost?

This conference is free to eligible public library staff through funding from the Library Services and Technology Act for registration, lodging and designated meals. Transportation and other expenses are the responsibility of the library or individual. LSTA funds are awarded annually to the Missouri State Library through the Institute of Museum and Library Services, a federal agency that fosters innovation, leadership and a lifetime of learning.

Enrollment is limited. Applications are handled on a first-come, first-serve basis. However, there are two instances in which applicants may be wait-listed, even if the course is not full at the time their application is received. Applicants may be wait-listed if: there are more than two applicants from the same library system, or if the applicant is not from a public library. Public libraries must be tax-supported and eligible for State Aid. If openings remain after the registration deadline, these applications will be accepted in turn and notified within a few days. Confirmation notices and detailed information will be mailed to those accepted prior to the Institute.
